**What is Grad Night?** Grad Night is a Half Moon Bay tradition that provides a fun, safe, environment for our seniors on the night of their graduation. It's likely the last night they will all spend together as a group. It's a night full of fun, food, music, entertainment, and surprises. It runs all night – from 10pm until 5:00am.

**And – who plans all this?** All of us! Over 100 volunteers and chaperons are needed to plan, prepare, and chaperon this event. We need all the help we can get. Be a part of making this memorable event for the Class of 2018.

**When is it?** Grad Night begins after the graduation ceremony and reception on **June 14, 2018 from 10pm to 5am at the IDES Hall.**

## Senior Parent Checklist for Grad Night

- **Purchase a Ticket for your Senior** – Tickets cost \$60 until March 31, \$75 until May 26th, \$90 after. Or you can print off the forms here and complete them. Return them with payment to Ms. Acosta in the front office or mail them to Grad Night at P.O. Box 2401, El Granada, CA 94018. - **Make a Donation** – Every bit helps. Donate a case of water, a prize or gift certificate for the senior prizes at the event; donate an auction item, or add a bit extra to your purchase of the Grad Night tickets for scholarships.
- **Complete your Senior's Memory Lane Collage** – Every senior deserves a Memory Lane Collage! A collage contains photos of your senior's childhood/friends/family. Details will be available on the Grad Night website ([www.hmbhsgradnight.com](http://www.hmbhsgradnight.com)) in mid-April. **Your collage needs to be turned in by Monday of graduation week.**
- **Write letters for Mailbox** – Mailboxes are available for all attending grads. Parents, relatives, and friends can leave a note or card for your Senior. Details will be available on the Grad Night website ([www.hmbhsgradnight.com](http://www.hmbhsgradnight.com)) in mid-April. **Letters need to be turned in the last week of school.**
- **Mark your calendar and plan to participate in Work Days, June 12-14<sup>th</sup>** – Transform the IDES Hall for the big night and volunteer for the night of the event.
- **Arrange transportation home at 5am** – Once the student leaves the IDES Hall, the student is no longer under Grad Night committee supervision. We recommend a parent pick up the student at 5am. They will be tired.
